

## **Explanation:**

It is much easier to memorize short, pithy sayings than longer complicated passages. Jesus' own temptation and response in the wilderness is a great example of this.

**The bolder portions of each verse will lodge the text in our heart and mind,** the regular text accompanying the verse is there for a fuller meaning.

Many people get discouraged trying to memorize the exact references and give up. Don't! Even Bible writers only referred to authors or books or historical settings - they did not cite book, chapter and verse.

The important thing is getting the Scripture in your mind and heart so the Holy Spirit can speak to you through them.

Please note these verses mostly have to do with living a Christ-like life, not the Christ or the theology behind that lifestyle. Those verses are coming!

Some longer verses are truncated. They have an italicized word at the beginning of the sentence so you will know when that happens. Also, some phrases are taken from the middle of a sentence and are Capitalized at that point to emphasise the phrase.

I realize context is vital. A verse may mean something else depending on context, so...Study to show yourselves approved unto God!
